## MEDICAL NOTES

### Macular Degeneration

Macular Degeneration is an eye disease that is a progressive degeneration and thinning of

the central portion of the retina called the macula. This disorders results in loss of central vision.

Risk factors include: Aging, Family History, Smoking, High blood pressure, atherosclerosis, high cholesterol, obesity, high-fat diet, exposure to UV and blue lights.

Signs and symptoms include a form of distorted vision, slow recovery of visual function, visual acuity drastically decreasing, blurred vision, trouble discerning colors especially dark ones, loss of contrast sensitivity, and visual hallucinations.

As this disease develops, there is a progressive accumulation of yellow deposits called drusen in the macula, a part of the retina. This accumulation is believed to damage the retina over time.

This disease is divided into 3 stages. Early, intermediate and late. These stages are based partly on the size of the drusen.

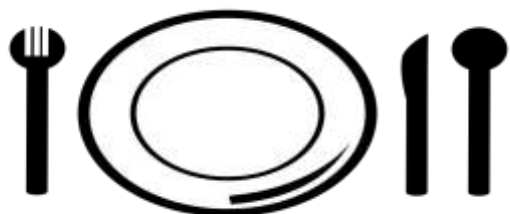
Early is diagnosed based on presence of medium sized drusen which is approximately the width of a human hair. Intermediate is diagnosed by larger drusen and retinal pigment abnormalities. Intermediate may cause some vision loss. Late stage is more retinal damage and you being to experience central vision loss.

Diagnosis is largely dependent on changes seen in the macula versus vision loss. You must have a dilated eye exam, Amsler grid test, Snellen eye test, fundus photography,

Electroretinogram, dark adaptometer test, Farnsworth-Munsell 100 hue test, and Optical coherence tomography test. All of these tests help in diagnosing the disease.

The treatment varies according to the type and stage. It is aimed at slowing the progression of the disease down. There are a few people with this disease that has total vision loss or blindness. In almost all cases, some vision remains. Reading becomes difficult.

Loss of vision can lead people to another place---a place of changes, adjustments and challenges. With vision we see colors, shapes, sizes, places and people. We vision loss, people can find a new way to see.

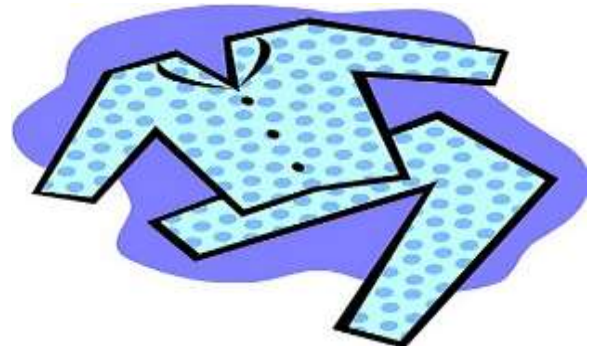
